RESOLUTION NO. 88- 115

DIRECTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO APPLY FOR AND
ACCEPT A GRANT FOR A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
WITH THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA)
REGION 9 TO ACCELERATE SOURCE INVESTIGATION ACTIVITIES
IN THE SAN GABRIEL VALLEY

WHEREAS:

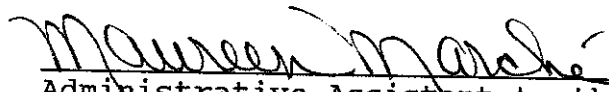
1. The San Gabriel Valley ground water basin provides drinking water for over one million people.
2. A portion of the San Gabriel Valley ground water basin is contaminated with volatile organic compounds at levels exceeding state and federal health standards.
3. The San Gabriel Valley ground water basin was placed on EPA's National Priorities List (Superfund) in 1984.
4. The Los Angeles Regional Board has been investigating sources of ground water contamination in the San Gabriel Valley since October 1985 in an attempt to identify potential responsible parties.
5. At its April 1988 meeting, the Los Angeles Regional Board endorsed a program strategy and action plan for accelerating the cleanup of the basin.
6. EPA is making available to the State Board a grant which would fund additional staff positions to accelerate source identification activities in the San Gabriel Valley.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Executive Director or his designee is directed to apply for and accept a grant and enter into a cooperative agreement with the EPA to accelerate source investigation activities in the San Gabriel Valley.
